Winemaker Notes

2021 was a perfect growing season in the Russian River Valley and this wine showcases that immensely. The color is a light purple in the glass with a brilliant glassiness. The nose is brimming with red fruit and wild berries. Upon tasting, the wine is nicely fruit forward but in balance with baking spices and earthy notes in the background. A balanced acidity is welcoming and not overbearing with a finish that keep delivering red fruit flavors and baking spice.

Vineyards

The 2021 Russian River Valley Pinot Noir was produced using fruit from two vineyards in the AVA: Moore Family vineyard and Hogan's Run vineyard. Moore family is located outside Sebastopol and Hogan's Run is located in the middle reach of the Russian River Valley. Each give their own unique characteristics and impacts to the fruit and finished wine.
