Winemaker Notes

Our 2023 Rosé of Pinot Noir is made in the traditional method, taking whole clusters of Pinot Noir and lightly pressing them to release the juice. The wine is barrel fermented in neutral French oak. The result is a wine with a perfect light pink hue and incredible delicate red fruit aromatics. A crisp acidity perfectly balances out the wine and makes it the quintessential pairing for warm summer days. Only 75 cases produced.

Vineyards

Our Rosé of Pinot Noir is produced using fruit grown in Forestville at the Rowe Family Vineyard. It is a small, roughly half acre lot that produces Pinot noir with great acidity and bright red fruit flavors. This makes it perfect for classical rosé.
